



Children in the Clubhouse

As we continue to make strides in becoming a more family-friendly Club, the well-being and safety of all of our Members and their guests are our top priorities. For this reason, the following family-oriented policies while in the Clubhouse are meant to ensure that everyone feels welcome and comfortable while using the facilities:

- Children under the age of 7 must be under the close supervision of an adult caregiver while on the premises of VGC. Golf courses have a myriad of hazards for small children, including power carts, heavy equipment operation, flying golf balls and swinging golf clubs.
- Children of guests or Members under 12 who are not engaged in Junior Golf programs should not be on the golf course, practice areas or the path adjacent to the first tee unsupervised under any circumstances.
- Junior Members between the ages of 7 and 11 must be accompanied on the course by an adult Member, a Junior Member over 16 or a staff member from the Pro Shop.
- Parents of children, whether Members or guests, must at all times be mindful of the expectation of peaceable enjoyment of the Club by Members, and must closely supervise their children both inside the Clubhouse or on the grounds.
- The 19th holes are considered to be adult areas only and those under the age of 19 are not permitted. Junior Members should use washroom facilities near the existing Junior Locker Room.
- Golf carts may only be operated by individuals that have a valid driver's license and be over the age of 18.
