



Course Project Policy

During project work the Links Department will modify golf course set-up or close one (1) or more holes as required to complete work and for the protection of Staff, Members and Guests:

- Renovation of one (1) or more holes: hole(s) closed.
- Tee renovation: tee will be closed, alternate tee or fairway tee provided.
- Fairway renovation: all or part of fairway closed.
- Green renovation: green closed, temporary green where possible without affecting safety.
- Greenside Bunker Renovation: green closed, temporary green where possible without affecting safety.
- Fairway Bunker Renovation: all or part of fairway closed.
- Practice Facility Renovation: practice facility closed (putting or chipping green, practice range, #15 practice fairway), hole closed or modified as required (#15)
- Cart Path renovation: as determined by location of cart path; tee will be closed, alternate tee or fairway tee provided, all or part of fairway closed, hole closed.

Course Closure Policy

During inclement weather or abnormal ground conditions the Links Department will modify golf course set-up, restrict cart access or close the course as required for the short-term and long-term protection of turf health:

- Frost or snow – course will be closed.
- Frozen green – Defined as unable to change pin location on putting surface, including practice facilities: green will be closed, temporary green provided if ground conditions permit.
- Standing water on green – green will be closed, temporary green provided if ground conditions permit.
- Green with documented turf health issues – Green will be closed when putting surface is measured at equal to or greater than 0.400 inches of penetration using Field Scout True Firm tool, temporary green provided if ground conditions permit.
- Abnormal ground conditions, saturated turf or standing water on fairways – defined as ground conditions resulting in turf damage caused by cart traffic: medical carts only or no carts allowed.
