



Frost Policy

When play on the course is delayed due to frost, the primary concern is the protection of the golf course itself and that we give our Links Department enough time to properly assess and prepare the course for play.

In light of this, our winter start times will be moved back an additional 15 minutes to allow the Links team to make a more educated assessment of the course at sunrise. Frost typically settles or lifts right at sunrise and we need to have some leeway to make a proper decision.

In the event of a frost delay longer than 1 hour, there will be a 12:00 noon shotgun and players will be able to move their morning tee times into that start time. If players have a tee time that is after 12:00, they will be assigned a starting hole in the noon shotgun but they may show up after that time and join in the play on the course.

If there is a very light frost that is anticipated to lift quickly, groups will be placed on the golf course in the position that they would have been in and commence play 1 hour after scheduled (ex: 8:00am tee time would tee off on hole # 5 at 9:00). The Pro Shop will make the hole allocations and groups are not permitted to play past the 18th hole unless there is an open time. This will still allow for Winter play, but will give the Links team a proper amount of time to take care of the golf course and pro-actively prepare it for play.
