TO APPLY FOR GOLF MEMBERSHIP, YOU WILL NEED THE ENDORSEMENT OF TWO ACTIVE MEMBERS OF VICTORIA GOLF CLUB, ONE TO ACT AS PROPOSER AND ONE AS SECONDER. SHOULD THIS NOT BE POSSIBLE, YOU MAY REQUEST TO BE PROPOSED AND SECONDED BY OUR MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE.

Waitlist C

Currently we have vacancies on our Waitlist C for those wishing to apply for Active membership at Victoria Golf Club. Waitlist C requires a non-refundable \$5,000 + GST deposit which will be applied to any future entrance fee payments. There are no playing privileges while on Waitlist C and future entrance fee rates are subject to change. Once a space comes available on Waitlist B, applicants will advance forward.

Once you have decided to submit your application, you will meet our professional team and Ambassadors of the Club. During this process, your application will be reviewed by our Membership Committee and Board of Directors to ensure it meets our Club requirements.

The Historic Tudor style 1920's Clubhouse holds a proud place on the National Heritage Register. You will enjoy Club facilities such as: The Pro Shop, men's and women's locker rooms, junior clubhouse and welcoming dining facilities, all surrounded by our historic links. VGC is a popular venue for private events and weddings; and a spectacular place to play golf 364 days a year (we only close for Santa!).

The course is playable year-round, thanks to the multi-million dollar capital improvements in drainage and irrigation and our state-of- the-art Turf Care Centre. Our holes play so differently from one day to the next, even our long-time Members say they experience something different each and every time out.

In its 14 years, the Evans Program has awarded 8 caddies full four-year education scholarships worth millions of dollars.
- 9 PHILOSOPHY OF INNOVATION & INVESTMENT We take pride in our history, but we strive to embrace the present and prepare for the future. Recent capital projects include complete drainage and irrigation replacement (2004), renovation of all bunkers, construction of a state-of-the-art maintenance facility (2012) and a new kitchen (2015). Our most recent investment was our addition of the short game practice area in 2020.

EVANS CADDIE PROGRAM

In 1929, U.S. Amateur Champion Charles "Chick" Evans established a fund to send deserving caddies to university. Today, more than 100,000 golfers, including Evans Scholar Alumni, in Canada and the United States support the program assisted by proceeds from special events, endowments and the PGA Tour's BMW Championship.

In 2006, Victoria Golf Club became the first golf club in Canada to adopt a Caddie Program dedicated entirely to the Chick Evans Scholarship. Three of our former caddies have gone forward to graduate with honours from the University of Colorado. Currently, we have five more outstanding candidates at the University of Washington, including our 6th Scholar Angela Bowers and Canada's first female Evans Scholar was welcomed at the University of Washington for the fall of 2019. In 2020, Laszlo Torok and Lachlan Stewart were accepted to the University of Washington. To date, more than one million dollars in scholarships have been awarded.
